## Commencement of the 2<sup>nd</sup> phase of the tender for the sale of 20% of "ARIADNE INTERCONNECTION S.P.S.A."

The Company "ADMIE (IPTO) HOLDING S.A." (or "Company"), informs investors that the 2<sup>nd</sup> phase of the tender for the sale of 20% of the special purpose vehicle "Ariadne Interconnection S.P.S.A." started on 26.02.2024, while the submission of the financial offers of the interested parties will last until the end of April.

Ariadne Interconnection S.P.S.A is a 100% subsidiary of ADMIE (IPTO) S.A. and is the implementing entity of the Attica-Crete electrical interconnection.

Following the relevant decision of the Regulatory Authority for Energy, Waste and Water (RAEWW), which approved the eligibility of the schemes that had expressed their interest during the 1st Phase of the Tender (Expression of Interest), and following the signing of the necessary Confidentiality Agreements, IPTO S.A. proceeds with the sending of the Request for Binding Offers (RfBO).

The RfBO provides detailed instructions regarding the conduct of the 2<sup>nd</sup> phase of the tender. At the same time, following the acceptance of the terms of access, candidates will be given access to the Virtual Data Room (VDR), which has been created accordingly. The VDR includes the technical and financial data of the company, as well as the material deemed necessary for the formulation of the binding financial offers of the candidates. Bidders will be able to submit their bids until the end of April, after which IPTO's evaluation process will begin, which is estimated to be completed within the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter of 2024.
